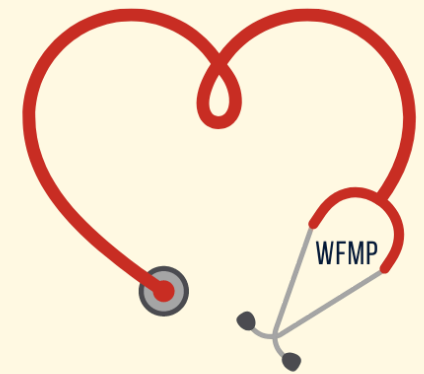

The goal of this program is to care for older adults and patients with advanced illness proactively and support their families and caregivers.

Who is this program for?

This program may be just right for patients who:

- are older adults living with complex medical needs or multiple chronic conditions who are not living in care homes.
- are experiencing increasing frailty or functional decline.
- have a serious or life limiting illness (at any age). You **DO NOT** need to be at the end of life to receive palliative support. The goal is to increase comfort and quality of life for as long as possible.
- would benefit from advance care planning or goals of care conversations.



What services are offered?

- Frailty Assessments
- Hospital followup
- Advance care planning and goals of care
- Education and resources on healthy aging, fall prevention and social needs.
- Palliative supportive care
- Support for families and caregivers
